



Reportable Items

Reportable Items regarding any Inbound or Outbound student

Should a Rotex become aware, formally or informally, of any of the following situations or any other circumstances that might adversely affect a student's exchange year, legal status, physical or mental health, personal safety or living situation, they should be reported to NSR-YEP immediately.

This list is not all-inclusive and Rotex should report any other concerns about a student they may have. Reports may be made to a Rotex Officer or a member of the NSR-YEP Committee.

Personal Safety

- Sexual, physical or psychological abuse of any kind
- Uncomfortable and/or unwanted sexual situations
- Bullying at school, in the community or in a host family
- Inappropriate advances or attention from a host parent, host sibling, Rotarian, Rotex, teacher or any other person of authority over the student
- Any thought of suicide or of harming themselves in any way.

Adjustment

- Severe homesickness
- Excessive contact with home country, be it family or friends
- Failure to disconnect from home and/or failure to engage with host family, school or community
- Depression and/or withdrawal from social activities
- Severe isolation or loneliness, i.e. no friends or connections at school or in the host community

Host Club

- Being ignored by, or no interaction with, host Rotary Club, Club Counselor or YEO
- Failure to receive monthly stipend from host Rotary Club

Personal Behavior

- Failure to learn host country language
- Excessive partying to the point that it interferes with family and/or school
- Failing or dropping out of school
- Unauthorized travels
- Committed relationships to the point that they interfere with family and/or school
- Use of prescription drugs not provided by a North Star Rotary approved physician and pharmacy
- Any dangerous, self-destructive or illegal behaviors
